In 1892 work began to convert an 18th-century mansion (Balvenie New House) into a distillery. The building took fifteenth months to complete and on the 1st of May 1893, the first distillation took place at the Balvenie Distillery.

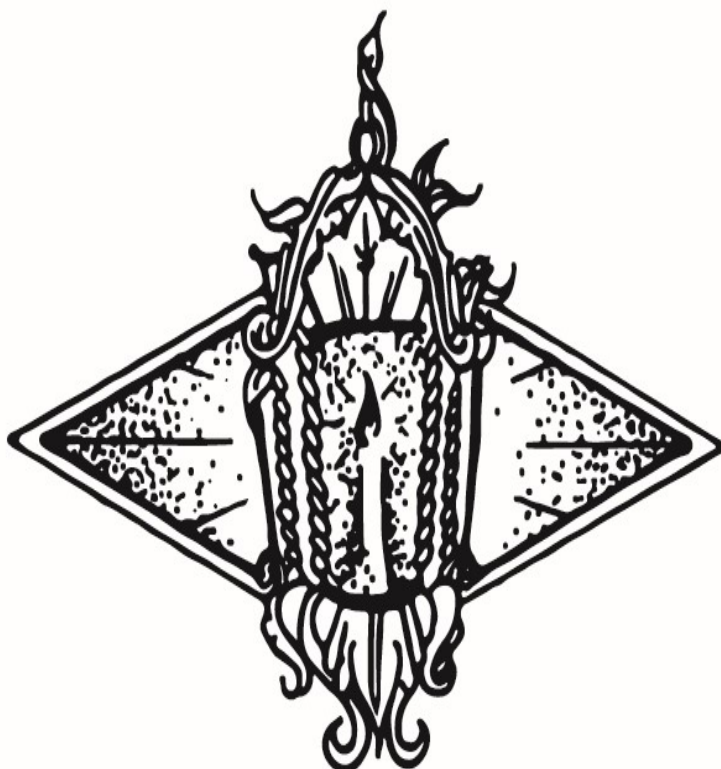

JAPAN

Whisky production began around 1870, but the first commercial production didn't occur until 1924 when Shinjiro Torii, owner of Kotobukiya (later to become Suntory), embarked on what was to become his life's work: making Japanese whisky for the Japanese people. He built the first Japanese whisky distillery in Yamazaki, a suburb of Kyoto, an area so famous for its excellent water.

Torii employed Masataka Taketsuru as a distillery executive. Taketsuru had studied the art of distilling in Scotland and brought this knowledge back to Japan in the early 1920s. Whilst working for Kotobukiya he played a key part in helping Torii establish the Yamazaki Distillery. In 1934 Masataka Taketsuru left Kotobukiya to form his own company – Dainipponkaju – which would later change its name to Nikka. In this new venture he established the Yoichi in Hokkaido.

RUM

CACHAÇA

The third most widely consumed spirit in the world with 1.3 billion litres consumed annually. Cachaça is a distilled spirit, made from fermented sugarcane juice. Its spiritual home is Brazil, where production dates back to the 16th-century. When Portuguese colonisers brought the first cuttings of sugarcane to Brazil from the Madeira Islands.

Cachaça like rum, has two varieties: unaged (white or silver) & aged (yellow or gold). White cachaça is usually bottled immediately after distillation & tends to be cheaper (some producers age it for up to 12 months in wooden barrels to achieve a smoother blend). Dark cachaça, usually seem as the “premium” variety, is aged in wooden barrels & is meant to be drunk straight (it is usually aged for up to 3 years though some “ultra-premium” cachaças have been aged for up to 15 years). Its flavour is influenced by the type of wood the barrel is made from.

TEQUILA + MEZCAL

“Deeply embedded in the culture of Mexico, tequila and mezcal have a primitive character full of earth and fire.”

When I think of a drink that sums up Mexico, one spirit springs to mind: tequila. Made from the “hearts” of the agave plant, it is often confused with mezcal, another agave spirit, but the two drinks differ in flavour and in method of production.

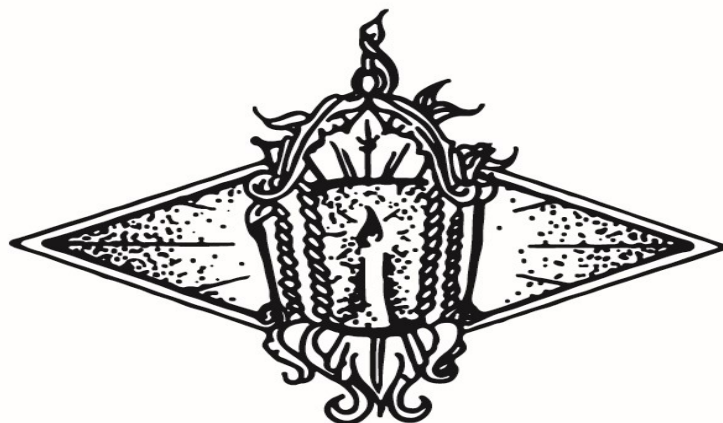
BAIJIU

Baijiu, also known as ‘shaojiu’, is a category of at least a dozen Chinese liquors made from grain.

Baijiu is usually made from fermented sorghum, although other grains may be used; some south-eastern Chinese styles may employ rice or glutinous rice, while other Chinese varieties may use wheat, barley, millet or even Coix lacryma-jobi in their mash bills. The qū starter culture used in the production of ‘baijiu’ is usually made from pulverized wheat grain or steamed rice.

Baijiu is the best-selling spirit in the world with 10.8 billion litres sold in 2018, more than whisky, vodka, gin, rum & tequila combined. Baijiu’s popularity in the country of 1.4 billion people makes it the world’s most consumed spirit, but outside of China it is not well known.

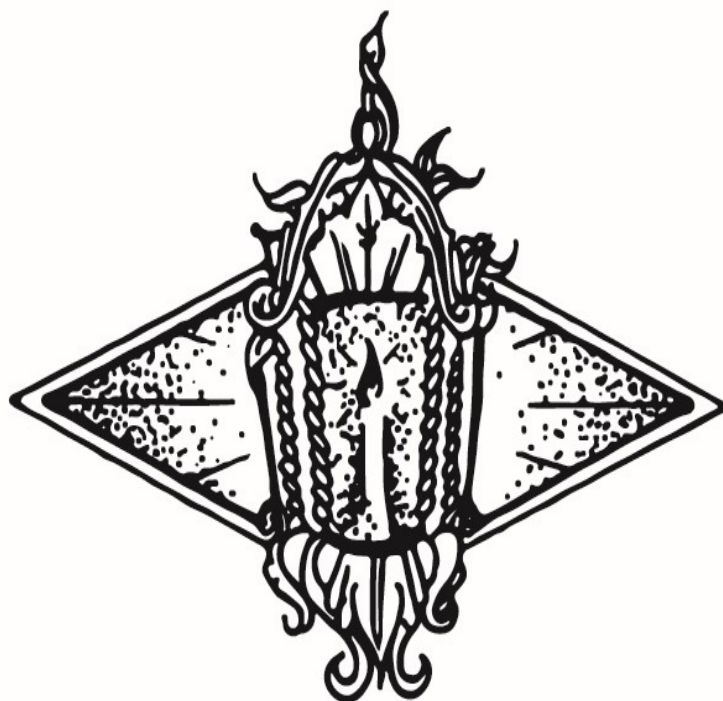

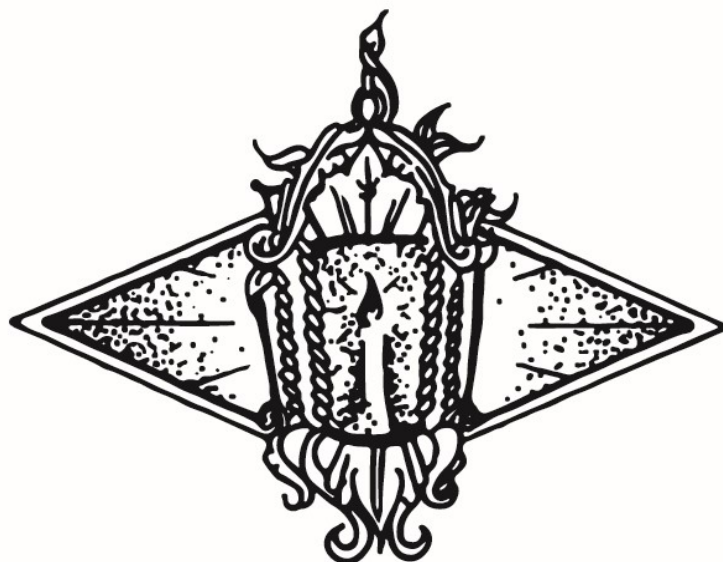

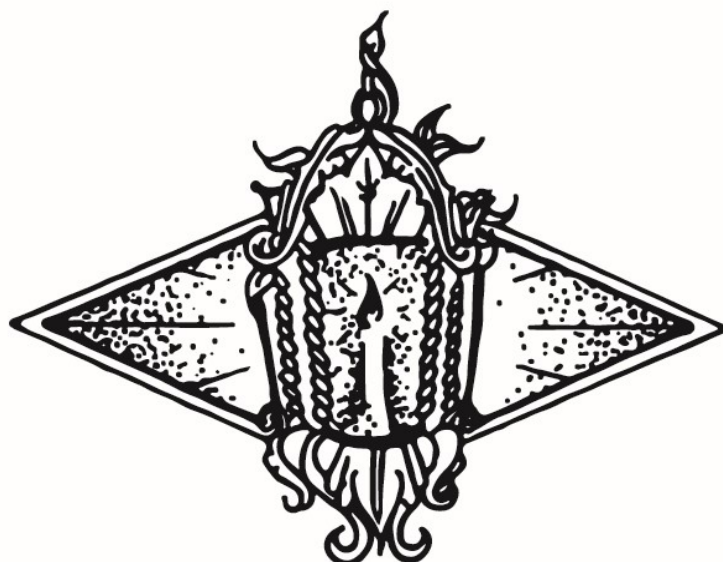
